The Joy of Reading



Goal: To improve students' listening, speaking, reading, writing and typing skills in Chinese.

Participants: All current students.

Date: From Oct. 1, 2008 to Mar. 31, 2009.

Method: Students should spend at least 20 minutes a day listening, speaking, reading, writing and/or typing in Chinese to earn one point (limit one point per day).

Activity		Details
L	Listening	Chinese CDs, tapes, parents reading stories, etc...
S	Speaking	Conversation, participating in the story telling contest, speech contest, reciting in Chinese, etc...
R	Reading	Chinese books, newspapers, magazines, etc...
W	Writing and/or Watching	Chinese homework (limited to 8 times a month) Chinese TV, tapes, movies, etc...
T	Typing	Participating in Chinese typing contest

 Monthly Prize	Bring your monthly Reading Log to your teacher on the <u>first week of every month</u> . The teacher will give you a <u>Monthly Certificate</u> . This certificate will record your points for each month.
 “The Joy of Reading” Program Prize	At the end of the program every participant who has a total of 80 or more points can get a prize and <u>Certificate of Participation</u> .



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
